OHIO CLASSIC GRAND CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES!

Grand Championships are offered in *Western, In Hand, Youth, Junior Horse, and English* categories. Winners from all Preliminary Classes, Stakes and Championships are automatically entered into the Grand Championship Class.

There is no entry fee and one winner in each category.

Ohio Classic Grand Champions will be featured as "Best of Show" winners in the center spread of the Pre National Edition of the **National News** courtesy of the Ohio Classic.

With the exception of In Hand, Grand Championships will be conducted as NO CANTER classes. Horses will be exhibited at a Show Walk and a Show Gait equivalent to the gaits required in the Preliminary divisions for each.

Coming from the East (Columbus): Exit I-70 at SR 41 exit #59 and cross SR 41 as if returning to I-70. Make an immediate right turn on Laybourne Rd at the Army Reserve Unit Headquarters and proceed to the fairgrounds entrance on the right.

Coming from the West (Dayton): Exit I-70 at SR 41 exit #59. Turn Left onto SR 41. At the I-70 West entrance ramp, turn left as if returning to I-70. Make an immediate right turn on Laybourne Rd at the Army Reserve Unit Headquarters and proceed to the fairgrounds entrance on the right.
