IS AFFILIATED, SANCTIONED WITH OR POINTED BY:
PPWHA, MATWHA, PWHMD, NWAH AND UMH.
THE NAPC WILL STRICTLY ADHERE TO ALL RULES THAT
APPLY TO THESE ASSOCIATIONS. ALL SHOW RELATED
COMPLAINTS MUST BE BROUGHT TO THE ATTENTION OF
THE SHOW MANAGEMENT ALL PROTESTS & COMPLAINTS
WILL BE RESOLVED ACCORDING TO THE N.W.H.W. RULES.
ALL RULE VIOLATIONS WILL BE BROUGHT TO THE
ATTENTION OF THE GOVERNING ASSOCIATIONS. ALL
PERSONAL DISPUTES WILL BE BROUGHT TO THE BOARD OF
DIRECTORS OF THE PPWHA. AND NAPC MANAGEMENT.

NOTICE TO ALL NAPC EXHIBITORS: KNOW YOUR RULES

Most all of the NAPC Classes are NWAH approved and there
fore governed by the NWAH rules. If you are an amateur rider, it
still behooves you to become an affiliate member of the NWAH
for the price of \$25.00. It allows you your amateur card, (which
you will pay \$15.00 per season/ \$5.00 per show) yet it also gives
you the privilege of accumulating points and tracking through the
National Walking Horse Association as well as an up to date

Specific Rules

- 1) **All Horses must be unsaddled for DQP inspections.**
- 2) **All entries, scratch, & adds must be done one (1) hour
before the start of each session. If a horse is scratched
after the one (1) hour deadline, an entry fee will be
charged. After a horse is scratched, it can not be added
back to the same class. If a horse is added to a class on
a add sheet and later scratched, a entry fee will be
charged**
Make sure you are entered in the proper class.
- 3) **All adds & scratches must be done by an adult(18 &
over)**
- 4) **Non hooked-up overnight vehicles used as tack rooms
will be charged \$30.00 for the weekend. This will be
strictly enforced.**
- 5) **Holds on classes must be reported to the Secretary's
booth prior to the beginning of the session.**
- 6) **Versatility- we strongly recommend protection gear (i.e.
wraps, boots, etc. for your horse). Please have your**

- horse checked at the DQP before applying the
necessary equipment.
- 7) **Dressage classes will be run according to NWAH rules.**

- 8) **Spotted Saddle Horse (SSH) , United Mountain Horses
(UMH) & Racking Horse (RCK) classes will be run by
those breeds' rules unless otherwise stated in NWAH
rules.**
- 9) **All exhibitors must have an Amateur or Youth card. A
Temporary Amateur is available for \$5.00/Show or
\$15.00 for the Show Season.**

GENERAL INFORMATION (Diamond 7 Ranch Policy)

***NO STRAW – Shavings only. Bring your own or
purchase shavings at the show grounds for prevailing
rate, cash or separate check.(2 bales included in stall
fee)**

- *Positively NO SMOKING in building and/or stall areas.
- *NO fans will be permitted in the stall area
- *NO overloading of electrical circuits, no coffee makers, crock
pots, microwaves, refrigerators, vacuums, hair dryers or other
electrical appliances anywhere in the barns.
- *RV Campers-area is for camper hook ups only, parking there
will cost you a nights fee.
- *ALL Dogs must be on a leash while on Show Grounds.
- *No Trailer Parking or unhooking around or next to building.
- *Parking in front is reserved for vehicles without trailers and for
visitors. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- *NO FOUR WHEELERS, Motorbikes, Golf Carts, or bikes in the
building.
- *Absolutely NO overnight tie-outs. ALL horses must be stalled or
removed from the showground's after evening session.

THE GETTYSBURG BATTLEFIELD RIDE

***Gettysburg Battlefield Riders there is NO FEE to ride the
Battlefield. All riders MUST meet the following 4
requirements:***

- 1) ***Riders MUST fill out the appropriate entry forms for
insurance purposes. Entries to the ride must be
postmarked by August 26, 2009***
- 2) ***Riders MUST have horses stabled at Diamond 7 Ranch
beginning no later than Saturday evening Sept. 5, 2009.***
- 3) ***Riders MUST be on a gaited horse (TWH, UMH, RACK,
SSH)***
- 4) ***There will be a meeting at Diamond 7 with your trial
guide, Sam Fuson, Saturday afternoon during the
Carousel to give directions, organize and tell
Gettysburg stories.***

Directions to Diamond 7 Ranch

From Rt. 15 take Rt. 74 South approximately 4 miles,
turn right on Kralltown Road, next right onto Barren
Valley Road, next left onto Deardorff road. Diamond
7 approximately 500 yd. on right.
