

Election Task Force Membership Survey

The current election process for the NWAHA Board of Directors is through a 5 member nominating committee appointed by the Board of Directors of the organization as allowed in the NWAHA By-Laws. The nominating committee is then charged with selecting a qualified candidate for each position that is open on the BOD. They collect the applications and research the references and credentials presented for each applicant and verify the qualifications. It is also the responsibility of the Nominating Committee to inform the potential candidate of the responsibilities of a Director and the expenses involved with holding the position. The slate of candidates is then presented on a ballot and mailed to the NWAHA membership. Room is left on the ballot for write-in candidates.

The purpose of this survey is to measure NWAHA member satisfaction with this current system and to aid the Election Task Force (appointed by the NWAHA President) in their research on this topic.
