Please join me for a trail ride at the Kentucky Horse Park to benefit HORSES *and* HOPESM – a partnership I began with the Kentucky Cancer Program in 2008. Events are held across Kentucky to honor breast cancer survivors; to raise breast cancer awareness among fans; and to provide breast cancer education and mammography screening to horse industry workers.

HORSES *and* HOPESM started at Kentucky's four Thoroughbred racetracks – Keeneland in Lexington, Turfway Park in Florence, Churchill Downs in Louisville, and Ellis Park in Henderson. Since then, we've expanded to include other equine venues, including the 2010 World's Championship Horse Show.

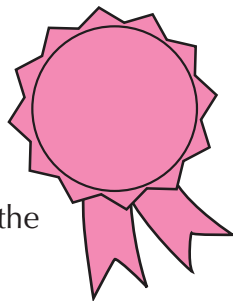
Since its inception, HORSES *and* HOPESM has taken education messages to more than 400,000 fans and 6,000 equine workers, and has screened more than 350 women in the industry for breast cancer.

About the Ride

The Kentucky Horse Park and its 1200 acres are called the "epicenter of equestrian life, sports and business." More than 10 miles of marked trails and open fields are available for the ride. Riders may explore the park by choosing one of two options:

- ❖ Enjoy a two-hour "**Guided Tour**" of the Horse Park that highlights scenic, historic, or otherwise special places along the way.
- ❖ Take an "**On Your Own Tour**" of the park trails, riding anytime between 11 a.m. and 3 p.m.

The Rules

Due to the number of riders, multiple riding levels, liability concerns, and to ensure the fun and safety of everyone, the following rules must be followed.

By signing the release form, you agree to follow these rules:

- Safety and courtesy to other riders is the priority.
- Outriders will be stationed throughout the park to answer questions and to ensure that these rules are followed.
- Riding helmets are recommended and encouraged.
- No stallions.
- No dogs are allowed at the event.
- No alcoholic beverages are permitted.
- Riders may not ride on the Steeplechase course (except where designated).
- No JUMPING or GALLOPING allowed.
- The ride is intended as mostly WALKING. Trotting and some controlled cantering will be allowed, as long as it does not take place in area where it may interfere with other groups.
- No reckless, careless, or discourteous riding allowed.

Other Important Details

- All trailers will be inspected by the Kentucky Department of Agriculture before entering the park. ALL horses must have valid proof of negative coggins test (within 12 months). A 30-day certificate of veterinary inspection/health certificate is required for all horses arriving from outside the state of Kentucky. Horses originating in Kentucky must have a valid certificate of veterinary inspection/health certificate dated within 12 months. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- Stalls are available for \$25 per day; \$15 for each additional day. To reserve a stall, email Donna Ward at dcwrcy@aol.com. Include your phone number in your reservation request. Also, include a separate check (\$25, plus \$15 for any additional nights) to the Kentucky Horse Park, along with your registration fee.
- Bring your own feed, hay and bedding, or it can be pre-ordered through Dever Show Services at 859-233-9702. Order at least 24 hours prior to arrival.
- Vehicles in barn areas for loading and unloading only.
- EMS, farrier, and veterinarian services will be available during the trail ride. Participants are responsible for any expenses incurred.
- Camping is available. Call (800) 370-6416 for reservations.
