General Show Rules and Procedures

- Entries must be inspected by DQP before each class
- *In accordance with new USDA regulations, all horses must be presented at inspection without saddle in either a halter or bridle only.*
- Proper shoeing within the guidelines set forth in the NWHHA Rulebook is required. Shoes may be measured by the DQP to ensure continued compliance to the rules. Penalties are enforced for horses not in compliance. Consult the NWHHA Rulebook for more info.
- All 1st Place winners must report to DQP Station immediately following the class.
- Only the exhibitor, horse and one assistant will be permitted in the inspection area prior to a class.
- If a class does not specify Amateur, it is Open.
- **AOT** denotes Amateur Owned and Trained, horse not to have any professional training in the 90 days prior to the show.
- **Novice Horse** – Horse not to have won ANY blue ribbons in 2009 at an NWHHA affiliated show or MOWHA show under present ownership
- **Youth Exhibitor** – Open to youth ages 17 and under as of January 1, 2010. No stallions are permitted in under saddle youth classes
- **Open Easy Gaited Classes** are open to all easy gaited flat shod horses. Neat attire consisting of long sleeved, collared shirt, pants and boots (and western hat, if in western tack) is permitted. Horses shown in Western Tack may use two hands. A horse shown in OEG **may** cross enter into any Trail Pleasure, Lite Shod or Plantation Pleasure classes. Any horse shown in OEG classes may only show in the OEG or Youth Championships (Class#53,55). Shoeing in OEG classes may be any shoe up to a Plantation Pleasure legal shoe (1 1/2" x 1/2").
- **Country Pleasure Classes** are open to all easy gaited flat shod horses. Neat attire consisting of long sleeved, collared shirt, pants and boots (and western hat, if in western tack) is permitted. Horses shown in Western Tack may use two hands. A horse shown in CP **may not** cross enter into Open Easy Gait, Trail Pleasure, Lite Shod or Plantation Pleasure classes. CP horses may show in TWH Youth, Showmanship, Model and Equitation classes. Any horse shown in CP classes may only show in the Country Pleasure or Youth Championships (Class#51,53). Shoeing in CP may be any shoe up to a Trail Pleasure legal shoe (3/4" x 3/8").
- If a class does not specify **Western** or **OT** (optional tack), *English Tack is required.* If the class is OT (optional tack), exhibitors may use either English or Western tack but not a combination of the two.
- No unattended cross tying in the barns.
- No transmitting communication devices are allowed in the show ring.
- **NWHHA Show Cards are required for anyone showing in Amateur classes, except Country Pleasure and OEG Pleasure classes.** These cards are available in the show office for \$15 per show or \$40 per NWHHA show year (October thru September) for non-NWHHA members. NWHHA Show Cards are free with NWHHA Memberships. Must be a NWHHA member to receive NWHHA points.
- Negative Coggins is required for all horses over the age of 6 months by the State of Ohio.

From I-70 – Take exit #91, Rome Hilliard Rd, go about 3 miles into Hilliard and follow signs to the fairgrounds
