- Pads, Bands, Saran Wrap, chains and other action devices are not allowed on show grounds.
- Youth 11 and under must use ASTM Certified Protection Head Gear when seated on a horse on show grounds.
- All Youth required to wear ASTM Certified Helmets for ALL speed events.
- No Australian Cutback Saddles can be used in the show ring.
- AOT: Amateur Owned & Training, no professional training within 90 days of show.
- O/T = Optional Tack
- Versatility classes will be judged per the NWA Versatility Book.
