General Show Rules:

Trail Pleasure: Horses may not show in Lite Shod or Plantation Pleasure classes

Country Pleasure: Horses may not show in TP, LS or PP classes, but can show in versatility.

Optional Tack: Either Western tack and attire or English tack and attire. Not a combination of both.

Youth: Youth 11 & under must have protective headgear. Youth between 12 & 17 are encouraged to wear protective headgear. All youth required to wear ASTM helmets in speed classes.

Coggins: All horses must have a current negative Coggins. Current = Jan 1 to Dec 31st of current calendar year.

No Australian Outback Saddles can be used in the show ring
