Miscellaneous Information:

- Pre-entry form must be filled out **completely**. Copy of current negative Coggins test should be attached to the entry. Check **must** accompany all pre-entries. Pre-entries must be postmarked by 2/24/12. (*Please note: Pre-entry rates will only be given on classes that are sent on pre-entry forms. Classes may be scratched at the show without penalty, but classes that are added at the show will be charged the regular class fees.*) Copy of NWA Membership card should be attached to the entry form.
- Stall Reservations should be made as early as possible. If you want to be stabled with someone else, be sure to note that when you reserve your stalls.
- NWA Show Card #(or Show Card Application) Required for all exhibitors except Youth and Country Pleasure exhibitors.
- NWA Membership # required to be eligible for year end high point awards.
- NWA Youth Card # Required to be eligible for NWA Year End High Point Awards
- Date of Birth required for Youth Riders
- Hunter classes **MUST** have at least 3 entries and be pre-entered so we can have jumps available. Scratches in these classes will not be refunded due to the high cost of renting jumps. Helmets are required for hunter classes.
- Classes must be entered at least 4 classes ahead
- There is no charge for the Stick Horse Class (#29) or the Tots Lead Line Class (#30). The Judges will jointly award one set of ribbons for these classes.
- The Water Glass classes will be run twice (once for each show). Each judge will preside over a class so that double points can be awarded in these classes.
- Horses entered in Barrels and Pole Bending will run these patterns twice so that double points may be awarded in these classes. Each Judge will preside over a class.
- Dressage times will be assigned and emailed to exhibitors that pre-enter and provide an email address. There will be three Intro tests and two tests offered in the other levels. Exhibitors are allowed to show in two levels (4 possible tests per exhibitor). Helmets are required. Schooling attire is acceptable.
- Dressage Seat Equitation: NWA rules allow for dressage classes to be ridden in any english tack. Snaffle bits conforming to NWA dressage rules are required as in any other dressage class.
- Novice Horse classes are open to horses which have not won three first place ribbons. Eligibility of a novice entry is established as of the date of the closing of entries.
- Jr. Horse classes are for horses 2, 3 and 4 years old.
- All Day Pleasure classes are open to any gaited horse, to be judged at the trail walk and favorite gait. The class is open to any horse, any division, and it is not restricted to amateur riders. The horse is judged on its appearance of being a horse that one could ride all day, so it should be smooth gaited and well-mannered. Horses that require strong contact or pull on the reins will be penalized.
- NWA Helmet Rule: Riders age 11 and under are **required** to wear an ASTM/SEI certified helmet at all times while mounted. All youth riders in speed and jumping events are **required** to wear ASTM/SEI certified helmets. All youth riders are encouraged to wear an ASTM/SEI certified helmet while mounted on a horse on the show grounds.
- There will be no cross entries between Novice Trail Obstacle and Advanced Trail Obstacle. Novice Trail Obstacle will be restricted to horses that have not won a blue ribbon in Trail Obstacle. Trail Obstacle will have assigned times for each entry. Please check in the office.
- The Panty Race class and the Catalog Race class will only be judged once based on time but will qualify for placings in both shows.
- Double Rider Class- Two riders, one rider will ride each way of the ring. Exhibitor donations will fund the winner's "pot". ½ of "pot" will be awarded to first place under each judge. One class fee and winnings will be awarded to the rider on the entry. Check in the office or listen for announcements for the amount of the "pot".
